

Prayer of Authority

A. Overview

1. The Five Verses are Mark 11:22-26 and are taught at three levels.
 - a) Prayer of Faith
 - b) Prayer of Agreement
 - c) Prayer of Authority

B. Prayer of Authority

1. These signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; Mar 16:17
2. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. Joh 14:14
 - a) [Yes] I will grant [I Myself will do for you] whatever you shall ask in My Name [as representing all that I Am].
 - b) If ye shall **demand** any thing in my name, I will do it and **if it does not exist**, Joh 14:14
I will make it for you.
Refer Strong's Greek Concordance G154 & G4441 for "demand" & G4160 for "make."
3. Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: Act 3:6
In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.
4. And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see Act 3:16
and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness.

C. Five Verses in the context of Authority

1. Mark 11:22 Have the Faith of God. (Douay-Rheims).
 - a) God believes that whatever commands He issues, they come to pass.
 - b) Children of God should also believe that, whatever commands they issue in the Name of Jesus, these also come to pass.
2. Mark 11:23 Have Faith in your words.
 - a) Speak, declare, prophesy the promises of God with authority.
 - b) Your words will come to pass if you don't doubt in your heart.
 - c) Life is in the power of your tongue. Pro 18:21
 - d) God lives in you and He is life.
 - e) Let the abundance of life come out of your heart with confidence. Matt 12:34
3. Mark 11:24 Have Faith in your Prayer
 - a) Jesus said that you **will** have "them" when "them" meets 3 conditions.
 - b) The three conditions are: (1) Desire (2) Pray (3) **Believe** that you received at the time when you prayed.
 - c) When you prayed, you did so in faith; after you pray, declare the results with authority and confidence. It has been done. You have received. Because you have received, thank God for the answer.
 - d) Because you have the Faith of God (i.e., believing that your words come to pass), you know that it has already been done, so you start acting like it.
 - e) Start speaking as if you believe that it has been done, both in normal conversations and with affirmations.
4. Mark 11:25-26 God is the power behind your authority. Heb 1:3
 - a) God backs up your words of authority with His power, so you need to remain obedient to and be in unity with Him, so you choose to forgive everybody.
